

Cookie and Browser Storage Notice

Version 1.2.3 · Effective September 1, 2026

This notice covers everything Tero places in your browser — cookies and similar technologies alike. The inventory below is complete: it was taken from the application's code and verified in a live browser, not written from intentions.

The inventory

Authentication cookie — name begins sb - followed by our database project's identifier (for large sessions it may split into numbered parts). First-party, set by our sign-in system when you sign in. Purpose: keeps you signed in as you move around the app and between visits. Category: strictly necessary. Duration: persists between visits; removed when you sign out, and the session it carries expires and is refreshed on the server's schedule regardless of the cookie's own lifetime.

tero-estate — first-party, set only if you belong to more than one estate and choose one in the estate switcher. Purpose: reopens the app to the estate you last chose on this browser. Category: functional preference, storing a choice you made deliberately, kept per browser. Duration: up to one year. It is readable only by our server, and it contains only the identifier of the estate/workspace last selected on that browser — not your name, email address, phone number, or any of the estate's workspace content. It has no advertising or analytics purpose.

Offline cache — a service-worker cache (not a cookie) holding exactly two files: a basic "you're offline" page and the Tero logo, so something sensible appears without a connection. Nothing about it leaves your device.

Push registration — only if you turn on push notifications for a device, your browser's push service (Apple, Google, or Mozilla, depending on your browser) creates a delivery registration. Turning push off, or asking us to erase your data, removes it.

What we do not use — no analytics or advertising cookies, no third-party cookies, no localStorage, sessionStorage, or IndexedDB, no fingerprinting. Nothing here follows you across the web.

Why there is no consent banner

Everything above is either strictly necessary to deliver the service you asked for (signing in, staying signed in) or stores a preference you set yourself through a deliberate action (choosing an estate, enabling push on a device). Tero currently treats that preference storage as functionality you requested, subject to applicable law in your jurisdiction. Tero sets nothing before you sign in, and nothing for advertising, analytics, or cross-site tracking — the categories consent banners exist for. If we ever add storage outside these categories, we will ask first.

Technical logging is separate

This notice covers your browser. Server-side technical records — request logs, sign-in attempt logs, error logs — are described in the Privacy Policy's "Technical and security data" section.
